Norfolk:

To the Constables of the Town of Wrentham in the County of Norfolk:

Greetings:

You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to notify and warn the qualified voters of said Town of Wrentham to assemble at the King Philip Regional High School, 201 Franklin Street, Wrentham, MA, at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, April 25, 2011 then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see what action the Town will take with regard to unpaid bills outstanding, or overdrafts from prior year(s), and to appropriate by transfer from unappropriated available funds in the treasury, or appropriate by transfer from funds previously appropriated to other accounts, a sum of money for the same, or take any other action relative thereto. (Finance Committee)

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, appropriate by transfer from available funds in the treasury, or appropriate by transfer from funds previously appropriated to other accounts, a sum of money to supplement the current Fiscal Year 2011 operating budgets, or take any other action relative thereto. (Finance Committee)

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, appropriate by transfer from available funds in the treasury, or appropriate by transfer of funds previously appropriated to other accounts, or by borrowing a sum of money for repayment of ALS services to the Town of Norfolk, or take any other action relative thereto. (Finance Committee)

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, appropriate by transfer from available funds in the treasury, or appropriate by transfer from funds previously appropriated to other accounts, a sum of money to be used for Fire and Police Retiree prescription co-pays, or take any other action relative thereto. (Finance Committee)

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, appropriate by transfer from available funds in the treasury, or appropriate by transfer from funds previously appropriated to other accounts, a sum of money to purchase or lease and to install an auxiliary receiving station for Public Safety Communications, to be expended under the direction of the Chief of Police, or take any other action relative thereto. (Finance Committee)

ARTICLE 6: To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the account established under Article 25 of the Special Town Meeting of November 12, 2002 (septic system upgrade loan program) to the General Fund in order to offset the Town's payments to the Massachusetts Water Pollution Abatement Trust (MWPAT) in connection with that program, or take any other action relative thereto. (Finance Committee)

ARTICLE 7: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, appropriate by transfer from available funds in the treasury, or appropriate by transfer from funds previously appropriated to other accounts, a sum of money to fund the milfoil and tapegrass aquatic weed control program at Lake Pearl, or take any other action relative thereto (Board of Selectmen)

ARTICLE 8: To see if the Town will vote to grant the Board of Selectmen permission to sell surplus property or materials (exclusive of buildings and land) of the Town no longer needed by the Town, or take any other action relative thereto. (Board of Selectmen)

ARTICLE 9: To see if the Town will vote to amend the Personnel Bylaws as recommended by the Personnel Board, or take any other action relative thereto. (Personnel Board)

ARTICLE 10: To see if the Town will vote to amend Section 1A of Article 1 of the General Bylaws to read as follows:

Section 1A: For the transaction of other business pertaining to the prudential affairs of the Town, the annual meeting shall be held on the second Monday in June. Any adjournments shall be regarded as parts of the same meeting called for in the Warrant for the annual meeting, or take any other action relative thereto. (Board of Selectmen)


ARTICLE 11: To see if the Town will vote to delete (in its entirety) Section 4 of Article 10 of the General Bylaws, or take any other action relative thereto. (Board of Selectmen)


ARTICLE 12: To see if the Town will vote to adopt MGL Chapter 30B, Section 22 – Governmental Preference for the Procurement of Products and Services by Businesses with their Principal Place of Business in the Commonwealth, or take any other action relative thereto. (Board of Selectmen)


ARTICLE 13: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to purchase, or take by eminent domain, and to raise and appropriate a sum of money to fund said purchase or taking along with all legal costs associated with the obtaining of temporary construction easements or permanent easements related to the Taunton Street Reconstruction project as shown and identified on a plan entitled "Commonwealth of Massachusetts Highway Department Taunton Street Roadway Improvement in the Town of Wrentham, Norfolk County, 25% Submission" dated August 18, 2009 prepared by BETA Group, Inc., as revised or amended, which will be delivered to and be made available at the Town Clerk's Office fourteen (14) days before the date of the Town Meeting; or take any other action relative thereto. (Board fo Selectmen)
