**To the Constables of the Town of Wrentham in the County of Norfolk:
Greetings:**

You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to notify and warn the qualified voters of said Town of Wrentham to assemble at the King Philip Regional High School, 201 Franklin Street, Wrentham, MA, at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, July 18, 2016 then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to amend the action taken under Article 14 of the 2016 Annual Town Meeting by voting to appropriate, borrow, or transfer from available funds, an amount of money to be expended under the direction of the Wrentham School Committee for the Delaney-Vogel Elementary School Roof Replacement Project which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program and for which the Town may be eligible for a school construction grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA") without the requirement of a debt exclusion vote under G.L. c. 59, § 21C (Proposition 2 1/2). The Town acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs the Town incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the Town. Any grant that the Town may receive from the MSBA for the Project shall not exceed the lesser of (1) Forty Six and Fifty Eight hundredths percent 46.58 percent (%) of eligible, approved project costs, as determined by the MSBA, or (2) the total maximum grant amount determined by the MSBA. *or take any other action relative thereto.*


