**Minutes of the State Primary Election
September 4, 2018**

Polls were declared open at 7:00 a.m. by Warden Mary Geromini. There were three (3) voters standing in line to cast their ballots. Sample Ballots, Instructions to Voters, Voters Bill of Rights, and Zero Tabulations from Precinct 1, Precinct 2 and Precinct 3 were posted. The AutoMark handicap voting machine was turned on and operational.

Town Clerk, Cynthia Thompson, swore in and thanked the Election Workers for coming. It was going to be a hot and humid, 95 degree day. She reviewed the three (3) ballot choices and how ballots would be identified in the check-in/check-out books.

Reminders were given to poll workers that individuals enrolled in a party must take that particular ballot. Unenrolled voters and members of political designations may choose which ballot to receive.

As always, a special shout-out to Department of Public Works, the Elementary School custodians and the Wrentham Police Department who helped with the setup and take down of the equipment.

Officers on duty were: Officer Peter Preston, Officer Stephen Eaton, Sergeant Jeffrey Smith and Sergeant Daniel Morris.

The ballot boxes were opened by Sergeant Smith with Warden Mary Geromini observing. The boxes proved to be empty and the zero tabulations were run and posted. The keys were handed over to Sergeant Smith and then to Sergeant Morris.

The turnout began slowly with 245 voters as of 10:00 a.m. At the time of the Primary, there were 8,402 registered voters in Wrentham.

Forty-six (46) Absentee Ballots were processed by the Precinct Clerks during the day.

No voters used the Automark voting machine. Unfortunately, the Automark stopped working as of 1:30 p.m. and the Clerk had to place a service call. It was too late to be serviced for the election when getting a call back at 7:00 p.m.

Turnout picked up a bit during the afternoon and the busiest time was between 5:30-6:30 p.m.

Some voters asked where the questions were on the ballots and other voters decided not to vote as they didn't like their choices on their party's ballots.

At 8:00 p.m. Warden Geromini closed the polls. Two voters came to vote at 8:05 p.m. The voting machines were programmed for tabulation and two sets of tapes were run. Tellers worked on reconciling their books and write-in votes were recorded. Results were completed around 9:40 p.m.

There was 1 provisional ballot, 16 spoiled ballots, and a total of 44 Affirmations. At 8:00 p.m. a total of 1392 voters cast their ballots, or 16.5%.

All materials were returned to Town Hall by 10:15 p.m. Un-official results were sent to the local newspapers and results were reported the Associated Press. Official results were posted in Town Hall on Thursday.

The Town Clerk gives a special thank you to the Assistant Town Clerk, Ellen Wojcik and all the staff members and volunteers who stayed all day through the hot weather to make it a successful election.
